SCHEDULE OF SERVICES

Brush and Branch Collection: 1st & 3rd Friday year-round; branches must be tied or in metal cans not to exceed 35 pounds; **branches in plastic bags will not be accepted.**

Grass Clippings: DPW no longer collects grass clippings. Homeowners may dispose of grass clippings a Nature's Choice collection site at 136 Foothill Road, Bridgewater. **Call 732-469-1500 for hours.** Proof of residency required; the service is free to all Borough residents.

Leaf Collection: Leaf collection begins on the second Monday in October and ends the first Monday in January. DPW will collect leaves throughout the entire work week; if leaves are not collected on Monday, they will be picked up sometime during the work week. Leaves (free of rocks, trash, sticks and grass) must be in biodegradable paper bags or cans and cannot exceed 35 pounds; **material in plastic bags will not be accepted.**

Yard Debris: Shrub clippings, weeds, and small rakings (free of trash, rocks, grass and branches) will be collected beginning the second Wednesday in March and end the first Wednesday in January. Material must be in biodegradable paper bags or cans and cannot exceed 35 pounds; **material in plastic bags will not be accepted.**

Additional option for biodegradable yard debris: Homeowners may dispose of biodegradable yard debris at Nature's Choice, 136 Foothill Road, Bridgewater. Call 732-469-1500 for hours. Proof of residency required; the service is free to all Borough residents.

Snow Removal: All vehicles must be off the roadways during a snow event to ensure curb-to-curb plowing and safe passage on Borough streets. **Do not discard snow on plowed road surfaces.** Snow will re-freeze and create hazardous situations. DPW understands the frustration of a cleared driveway plowed in but plow operators are doing what is required for the greater good of our citizens. DPW recommends waiting for the streets to be cleared prior to cleaning walkways and driveways. DPW prides itself on maintaining safe roadways and helping residents whenever possible.

Trash collection: For Thursday collection, place trash curbside no sooner than 6:30 pm on Wednesday evening. Three cans per collection are

permitted. Trash collection is managed by a private company, not the DPW. If trash has not been collected, please call **732-356-0258 ext. 5**.

Recycling: Recycling is under the auspices of Somerset County and is collected on alternate Thursdays. Questions should be directed to **732-469-3363**.

Bulk Collection: All bulk trash items (sofas, mattresses, grills, large appliances) are collected the second Friday of the following months: February, April, June, August, October and December. There are fees associated with bulk collection. Please call **732-356-0258 ext. 5** to schedule a collection date.
