



Message from the South Bound Brook Office of Emergency Management
regarding FEMA assistance for Ida-related recovery

FEMA has approved a Major Disaster Declaration in Somerset County (South Bound Brook) and other effected parts of the State of New Jersey. The declaration will allow individuals effected by the remnants of Hurricane Ida to register at www.disasterassistance.gov for direct assistance for Ida-related recovery, which may include home repairs, temporary housing, low-cost loans, and other programs to help recover from the effects of the tropical storm.

Beginning September 9, 2021, FEMA representatives will be in South Bound Brook conducting a door-to-door canvas in the flood effected areas of town. They will be providing residents with information and assistance in the registration for assistance.

The fastest way to apply for disaster assistance is still through DisasterAssistance.gov. You can also apply by calling 1-800-621-3362 (TTY 1-800-462-7585) or through the [FEMA mobile app](#).

To find help with needs that FEMA is not authorized to provide. Check with your local town officials, voluntary agencies, or by dialing your local 2-1-1.
